### **EQ Credit 4.1: Low-Emitting Materials: Adhesives and Sealants 1 Point**

The following materials meet the required VOC requirements for Adhesives and Sealants and can help contribute to earning EQ Credit 4.1 by complying with the South Coast Air Quality Management District ([SCAQMD](#)) [Rule 1168](#), Architectural Coatings, rules in effect on July 1, 2005 and rule amendment date of January 7, 2005.

- **NS 97 Exterior Primer:** 54 g/L VOC
- **NAC TAC Interior Primer:** 53 g/L VOC

### **EQ Credit 4.2: Low-Emitting Materials: Paints & Coatings 1 Point**

The following materials meet the required VOC requirements for Paints and Coatings and can help contribute to earning EQ Credit 4.2 by not exceeding the South Coast Air Quality Management District ([SCAQMD](#)) [Rule 1113](#), Architectural Coatings, Amended on July 13, 2007.

- **101 Floor Prep:** 0 g/L
- **SubSeal Liquid Waterproofing Membrane:** .22 g/L VOC
