



## Regional Materials LEED® Project Resources



Through the use of products manufactured within 500 miles of the project site, credits may be attained and assist in qualifying for LEED® Certification as outlined by the US Green Building Council Rating System Version 2.2.

The LEED® (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) Green Building Rating System is the nationally accepted benchmark for the design, construction, and operation of high performance green buildings. LEED Material Resource Credit 5.1 for Regional Manufacturing:

1 Point

- Regional Materials: 10% of building materials manufactured regionally, within 500 miles of the project.

LEED Material Resource Credit 5.2 for Regional Manufacturing:

1 Point (in addition to MR 5.1)

- Regional Materials: 20% of building materials manufactured regionally, within 500 miles of the project.
